Jerry Brown is scapegoating parolees and probationers for Oakland's problems as he runs for Attorney General. His newest scheme is to impose a curfew on new probationers and parolees - - arresting them if they leave their house after 10pm. In response to our protests, Jerry Brown, through his Press Secretary Gil Duran, said:

"The City of Oakland maintains a policy that embraces the hiring of felons... We understand that in order for people to survive and thrive, they must be able to work. **If you know any felons who need work, send them our way.**"
